# Distracted Driving Program

This free one-day course sponsored by the Madison County School Resource Officers will rotate at different high school campuses during the summer months. The class size will be no more than twenty students each day. The students will be required to be a minimum of fifteen years of age.



## Course Topics



- ⇒ Traffic Stop Etiquette
- ⇒ DUI Laws
- ⇒ Seatbelt Laws
- ⇒ Cell Phone Usage
- ⇒ Texting While Driving
- ⇒ Distracted Driving

## So How Does This Work?

Half of the course will involve PowerPoint presentations and classroom teachings to include DUI laws, seatbelt laws, window tint laws, television screen laws, traffic stop etiquette, cellphone usage and texting while driving, and driving while distracted. The second half will consist of hands-on driving by the students while undistracted and then while distracted.

The students will be graded on their first trip through the course with no distractions. On the second trip through the course, the ride-along Deputy will instruct the students to send a text message, read a laminated card that would be hanging from the rearview mirror to simulate reading a text message, retrieve a dropped item from the back seat, or change songs on an iPod. The students will also be graded on his second round, and the two scores will be compared. On the second trip the students will lose points for hitting cones, driving too slow and other traffic infractions.
